

# POLAND SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## The Poland Scholarship Fund Bylaws

(Adopted at the town meeting in 1975, amended - 1990 & 1994)

- 1.) The scholarships will be awarded to an individual wishing to go to college or technical school. The money can be used for tuition or books. "The check will be sent directly to the recipient of the scholarship."
- 2.) The scholarship check will be sent to the recipient after verification is received by the trustees that he/she has successfully completed their first semester of school.
  - A.) The scholarship will be given to a student who has been a resident for at least five (5) years or graduated from the Poland Community School.
- 3.) Three (3) requirements will determine the scholarship award. The eligible students will be judged on aptitude for chosen field of education, their overall activities and their financial needs; such as, but not limited to, cost of schooling. The award should be expended within a two (2) year period per Poland Scholarship Fund application signed by the applicant. If scholarship recipient voluntarily withdraws from school, he/she accepts responsibility to repay in full amount of their scholarship within (1) year of their withdrawal from school.
- 4.) The announcement of the scholarship awarded will be made immediately after the Board of Trustees finalize their decision as to recipients of all scholarships to be given.
- 5.) For anyone receiving a Poland scholarship: Both they and/or their parents must be Poland residents (Year round) at the time the scholarship is awarded.
